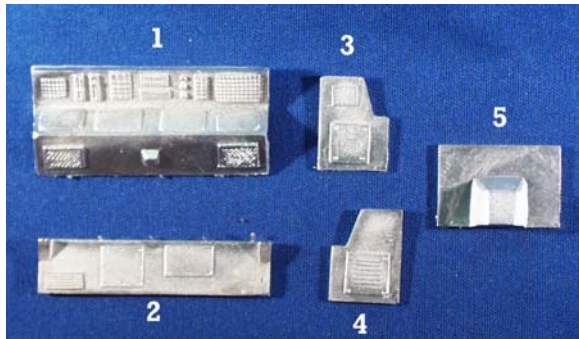


Kit comes with 5 different parts as shown below. Stands 53mm wide, 25mm deep, 25mm tall (without Screen) 45mm tall (with Screen).

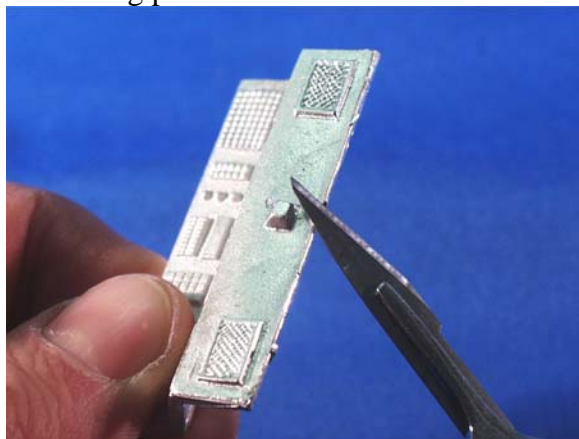


Part number **DEAL-72001a View Screen** or **DEAL-72001b Control panel** found in store shopping cart, category "Science Fiction Scenery".

Tools you will need:

The two primary tools you will need are super glue and a razor blade. The razor blade is good for cutting off burrs on the metal parts that are caused from gating in the casting process.

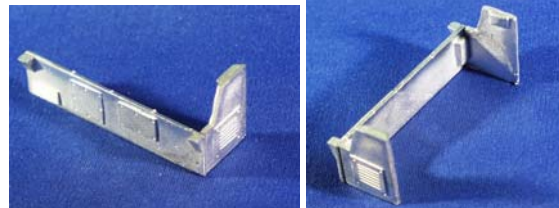


Other tools I like to have around are some form of needle nose pliers or pliers that have a cutting edge.

Insta-set is an accelerator spray that when applied to an area with super glue, makes the glue harden within seconds. It is nice to have if you plan on putting together many models or are pressed for time.

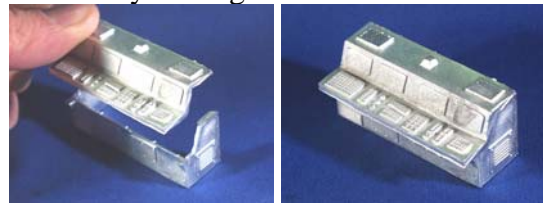
Step One:

Glue item 4 to item 2 as shown. Let dry and then glue item 3 to the other side of item 2. Be sure to keep items 2 and 3 at 90° angles against item 2. It helps to glue while sitting on a flat surface. Grills on items 3 and 4 must face outward.



Step Two:

Apply glue to the assembled tops of 2,3,and 4. Set item 1 in place, the back of the control panel is hollow since it will more than likely face against a wall.



Step Three:

If you purchased the View Screen kit, you have the option to attach item 5 to the top of the control panel. Prime with flat spray paint and use suggested acrylic based paints to detail this kit. If you are using oil based paints, then do not prime.
