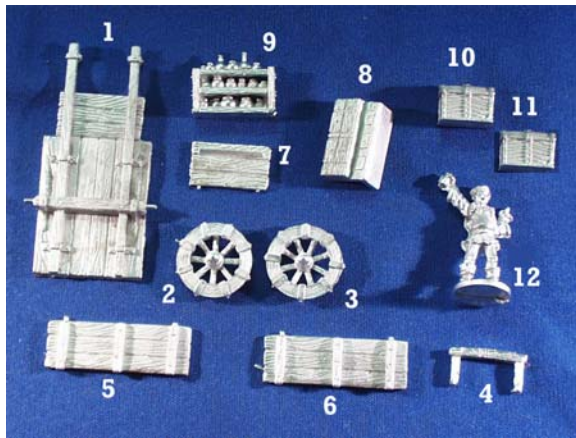


**Kit comes with 12 different parts as shown below.** Stands 45mm wide from wheel to wheel, 70mm long, and 30mm tall (not counting the rack with bottles).

### Tools you will need:

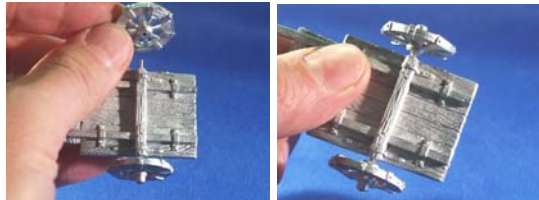
The two primary tools you will need are super glue and a razor blade. The razor blade is good for cutting off burs on the metal parts that are caused from gating in the casting process.

Other tools I like to have around are some form of needle nose pliers or pliers that have a cutting edge.

Insta-set is an accelerator spray that when applied to an area with super glue, makes the glue harden within seconds. It is nice to have if you plan on putting together many models or are pressed for time.

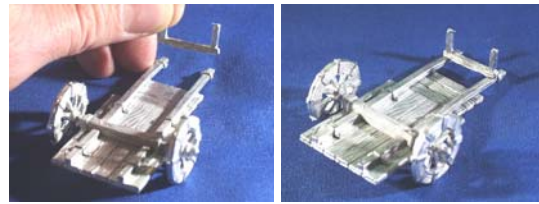
### Step One:

Glue both item 2 and 3 to the axel of item 1.



### Step Two:

Lay the Cart with wheels upside down (Smooth side down, Axel and Frame side up as shown) and glue item 4 at a 90° angle on the handle side.



### Step Three:

Turn Cart over and glue simultaneously item 7 to the rear of the cart in holes and item 5 to side. Both item 5 and 6 are identical pieces. Be sure to face item 5 with three support vertical members facing outward. Be sure to glue item 7 with upper tab or lip facing inward.



### Step Four:

You do not have to glue duplicate treasure chests items 10 and 11 to the Cart but you should use them as a counter weight by placing them in the front of the cart to keep the cart from tipping over backwards. The cart will be balanced too if you do not connect items 8 and 9 to the rear (drawers and rack of elixir).

Optional: Attach item 8 to rear panel and over the lip of previously attached item 7. Glue item 6 to finish the sides of the cart.



### Step Five:

Optional rack of elixir sits on back of chest.
